


Label Maker Program

Complete this assignment:

1. Use Visio Program to create a drawing of your form layout.
2. Write a Pseudocode describing the object names, their captions, and purpose.
3. Use Visual Basic to draw the form and write the code.

Use these attributes:

1. Name the Form "Label Maker"
2. Name the Project "Labeler"
3. Create labels they say: "Your Name:", "Address:", "City:", "State:", "Zip Code:"
Right justify all five.
4. Create five text boxes – one each for the above labels and name them.
5. Create three buttons that say: "Display", "Clear", "Exit" and name them.
6. Make "Clear" only available after you click "Display".
7. Make the "Display" button put all text information into a Label.
8. Add meaningful ToolTipText to all buttons and text boxes.
9. Make the "Clear" button erase all text boxes and reset the Focus to txtName.
