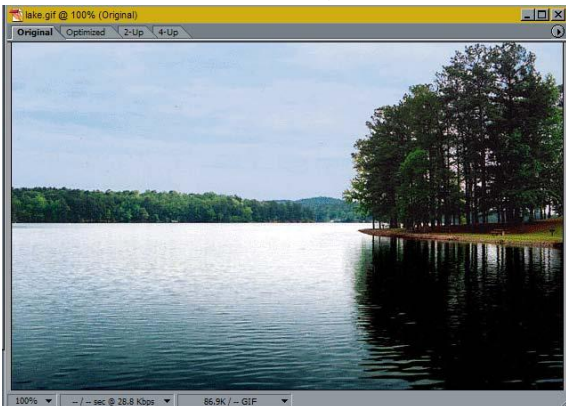


Animation Exercise

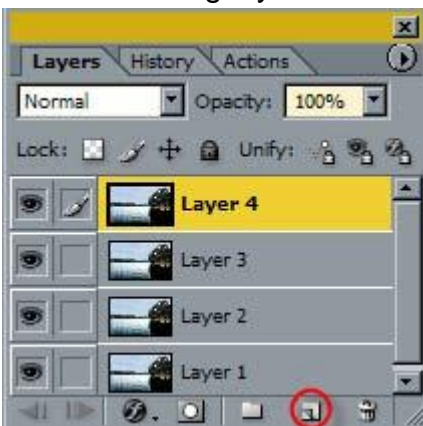
Step #1 - Open Photoshop and the picture lake.gif.

- A. Change Layer 1 from Indexed mode to RGB mode.
- B. Duplicate Layer and rename it Layer 1.
- C. Delete the background (Locked) layer.



Step #2 - Make three layer copies of the original layer.

- A. Drag Layer 1 onto the New Layer icon three times.
- B. Double click the new layers and rename them Layer 2, 3, & 4. You will get the following layer structure.



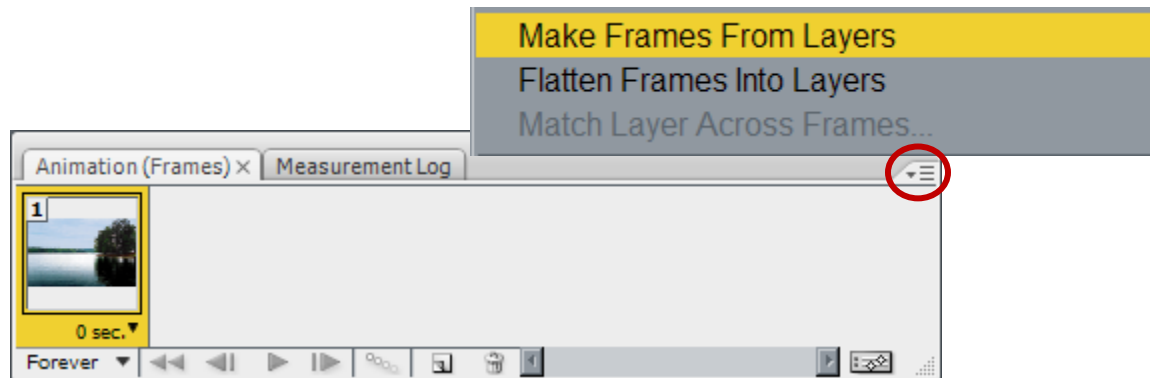
Step #3 – Create the ripple effect. (No changes to Layer 1)

- A. Use a selection tool to select the water from picture.
- B. Select Layer 2. Filter> Distort > Ripple (size: Medium Amount: 50%)
- C. Select Layer 3. Filter> Distort > Ripple (size: Medium Amount: 80%)
- D. Select Layer 4. Filter> Distort > Ripple (size: Medium Amount: 40%)

Animation Exercise

Step #4 - Create the Animation. Make Frames from Layers.

- A. Open the Animation window.
- B. Expand window and then click “Make Frames From Layers”.



Set #5 – Set Timing

- A. Set the timings for frames to 0.2 seconds.
- B. Set the no. of time you want to play the animation to Forever.
- C. Play animation.



Step #6 - Save your animation

- A. Choose File > Save for Web and Devices
- B. Check setting (see below)
- C. Click Save
- D. Save As “ripple.gif” and Save As type: Images Only (*.gif). Click Save.
